All applications must be received no later than March 15th, 2007 and should be accompanied by the prospective Coaches qualifications and experience and should clearly indicate the AAA Zone Team(s) and level(s) the prospective Coach would be interested in Coaching.

COACH SELECTION CRITERIA

- A. All Head Coaches must have their Level 2 or Intermediate HCCP certification.
- B. All Head Coaches must have (or be willing to obtain) their Speak-Out Training.
- C. All Head Coaches must pass a Criminal Records Background Check
- D. Experience:
Prior coaching experience as a Head Coach is considered an asset.
Experience in Junior, AAA, AA, A men's or women's sports is an asset
Advanced coaching levels or other certification showing commitment to personal improvement as coach is an asset

The Coach applicant must have qualified assistants ready should they receive the team. All Team Staff must have (or be willing to obtain) their Speak-Out Training and must pass a Criminal Records Background Check.

Other Considerations:

- 1 The Coach Selection process will be completed no later than the 15th of April, 2007.
- 2 AAA Coaches will be remunerated and total accountability is expected.

The Process:

- 1 The President of each AAA Zone Association will strike a Coach Selection Committee.
 - 2 Interviews will be scheduled by the AAA Zone Association Secretary, under the instructions of the AAA Zone Coach Selection Committee. These will be 30 minute interviews.
 - 3 The successful applicant will be notified no later than April 15th, 2007
